

Sweden's first charging station is inaugurated

In connection with the meeting of EU Ministers in Åre, County Governor Britt Bohlin will inaugurate Green Highway's and Jämtkraft's very first charging station for electric cars. An important step in driving forward the development of electric cars.

Jämtkraft's charging station in Åre is the first of a number of charging stations that will cover all of the Green Highway – Sundsvall, Östersund and Trondheim. The Green Highway will create a green transport corridor through investments in electric vehicles, charging infrastructure, renewable fuels, testing and development as well as building and promoting awareness of these.
